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TUITION

Company teams have two expense amounts: tuition and company fees. Tuition amount is based off the hours of classes per week. Company fees are based off of team placement and is calclulated off of how many dances and workshops the team will be attending.

TUITION

Due July-June. July and August tuition payments include all summer intensive classes and choreography fees for boot camp.

COMPANY FEES

Company Fees can be paid in full by October 1st, or in 10 payments from Sept-June. Company Fees include: Costumes, extra rehearsal and master class fees, choreography fees, competition fees, performance fees, team spirit fund, coaches travel fees, concert fees (concert costume, concert fee, pictures, digital video, participation award, concert t-shirt and shorts, and more).

ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

- NEW DANCERS FIRST-OF-YEAR TEAM ORDER: (Due July & Aug) team jacket (\$100), makeup kit (\$50-70), dance bag (\$30-\$55), leggings (\$30), new team attire (\$75)
- RETURNING DANCERS FIRST-OF-YEAR TEAM ORDER: (Due July) new team attire (\$75)
- ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP FEE: \$45/student or \$60/family
- TEAM PICTURES: \$60 minimum (Due in Oct/Nov)
- HIP HOP SHOES: \$60 maximum (Due in Nov)

AUDITION COMMITTMENT

Commitment deposit of \$100 is due on June 1st and will be applied to your final month of the season. It is non-refundable. This deposit confirms that you fully intend to commit to a performing company team and understand and agree to the cost and time commitment involved. It also confirms that you trust your dancer's best interest is the top-priority of our instructors and will not question team placements. We are professionals who care about your child and want them to enjoy dance for many years to come.

DIRECTOR NOTES

LETTER TO PARENTS

We are very careful when choosing a team for a student. No two students will progress at the same pace, even if they experience the exact same training. It's important to encourage children to focus on themselves, give their all, and be satisfied with their own accomplishments. Please trust the teachers and the directors. We are professionals and care about your child and want them to enjoy dance for many years to come.

Attitude and Progress

A willingness to learn, a favorable attitude, good attendance, practice, and dedication are key factors for accomplishment. As a parent, you play an important role in supporting your child financially, but your emotional support is of equal—and perhaps even greater—value. Encourage your child to be the best that he or she can be regardless of what others may achieve. Dance is an individual art form and children need to be allowed to achieve at a pace that's comfortable.

Making sure that your dancer enjoys their day at dance and continually progresses is most important. Please help children learn that hard work and determination will help them succeed!
