SAFER STUDIO GUIDELINES

The health of our staff, students, and families has always been our highest priority. Studio 56 Dance & Little Learners Preschool follows the Safer Studio guidelines, which prioritize a hierarchy of safety and wellness measures. They include, but are not limited to, wellness checks, amplified and frequent hand hygiene, enhanced environmental services, minimizing mixing and mingling via physical distancing practices, curricular and facility adjustments, and continuous parent communication. As a reminder as we are going into regular cold and flu season, it is important that we continue our combined efforts to follow these guidelines. Please continue to monitor your children and do not send them to class if they have a fever, cough, shortness of breath, sore throat, runny nose, etc. Thank you so much for everyone's enhanced awareness and efforts in keeping our dancers healthy.

Sending a child with symptoms to class in a mask is not an acceptable solution. Please keep children home when they are sick.

TEAM DANCEWEAR

We're filling final missing items from first of year orders this month. Remember, dancewear needs to fit now, so they look good for our fall performances! Leggings and leotards were fitted to be tight fitting. Tanks and shirts were fitted to be looser fitting. We're loving seeing all the new company gear at the studio!

HOW DO I CARE FOR MY DANCEWEAR? Your leotards have been handmade in the US and crafted with care for the best fit possible. We recommend hand washing your leotards in <u>cold</u> water with no detergent and either lie it flat or hang to dry. To keep colors vibrant, we suggest this for all studio wear (especially black items like our team tanks).

CHARACTER CURRICULUM- OCTOBER COMPANY FOCUS: CONFLICT RESOLUTION

As you know we feel being a part of a team is more than just learning how to dance. We try to teach students many valuable life skills and currently we are teaching Conflict Resolution. We know sometimes students can say

something to a teammate that may hurt his/her feelings – often they don't even realize what they're saying is being perceived this way. We are currently working with students to teach them how to politely and kindly respond to negative comments by saying things like "I'm sorry you feel like that, but I don't think that and what you said hurts my feelings." We feel teaching children how to speak up for themselves is a crucial life skill and the studio is a very safe place to learn how! Please help us at home by reminding your dancer how to politely respond to negative things that may be said to them in class. Please keep us informed if there is ever anything said to your dancer that makes them feel unsafe, uncomfortable (inappropriate topics/language) or consistent negative comments from the same dancer. We know students are often learning how to work together and sometimes personalities just don't mesh. We don't expect everyone to be best friends with every dancer on their team, but we do expect them to treat everyone at the studio with kindness and respect. We will always intervene when needed and dismiss any students who are consistently creating an unsafe, uncomfortable, or inappropriate environment.

COMPETITION SCHEDULE

Dates were announced for competitions and end of year showcase/concert at the first of year parent meeting. Make sure these are on your calendars!

As a reminder, the showcase and the concert are the final commitment to this season! It's very important for all dancers to attend both. Please reach out to us ASAP if your dancer ever has a schedule conflict with any performance so we have as much time to adjust as possible. From the Company Handbook:

When a dancer misses any performance, it is a huge letdown for her team. Dances have multiple formation changes, which means dancers will have to retrain, from memory, the habits learned over the last several months. They have partner parts that will now no longer work and will have to be majorly adjusted. This is not a small project for us to be able to accomplish. We CAN'T completely adjust dances in one week because someone can't be there. If arrangements cannot be made for a dancer to be at a competition, recital, showcase, or equally important event with his/her team, you will be subject to a \$150 re-space fee. Many times, we will need to hold extra rehearsals in order for us to give our dancers the best experience possible. Dancers that do not finish the entire year through the recital will forfeit their \$100 commitment deposit.

DRESS CODE REMINDER

As a reminder, beginning October 1st, dancers out of dress code may be asked to sit out of class. Parents will also receive a text message every time a student receives a dress code notice in class. The full dress code has been posted to the Company page HERE.

ATTENDANCE IN CLASSES

Attendance in classes is being monitored; all dancers need to be in their required dance classes each week. Dancers are responsible for knowing any choreography changes when they are absent. It may be required that dancers set up private lessons with teachers to get caught up for absences if they are behind, and dancers will be charged for private lesson fees.

DEMERITS UPDATE

We will be updating demerit reports the first week of each month. If your dancer is in demerit warning you will receive an email notice. Please make sure you are excusing absences online before you class starts! Also, when making up classes, don't forget to get a make-up slip from the teacher and place the make-up slip in the tuition box by the office. Please remember we will only excuse absences for reasons like the following: unavoidable school

conflicts, important family events that cannot be rescheduled around dance schedules, and sickness when you are contagious.



CHRISTMAS CHARITY PROJECT: Although we are not going to be performing in our annual Dance for Life Benefit Concert, we are still going to be collecting PJ's to donate to those in need of a comfy new pair of jammies this holiday. 1:1 LESSONS

When booking a 1:1 lesson ONLY do so if you are 100% committed to making it to that time slot. We have had a lot of changes, last minute drops even no shows. Please be considerate of our instructor's time. We are dedicated to meeting with you, make sure you keep that same dedication to keeping your scheduled appointment.

We try to keep 1:1 lessons open throughout the week all year long! These lessons can be used to work on technique, practice routines or clean your solo/duo/trio. We are always adding new lessons online, if you don't see lessons that work for your schedule, try checking back in a few days/weeks to see if there are more lessons available!
