DROP OFF & PICK UP REMINDERS

Drop-off is the first 10min of class and pick-up is the last 10min of class.

- Uppercase A (MWF): Drop off 9:00-9:10am, Pick up 11:50-12:00pm
- Uppercase B:
 - T/TH: Drop off 9:00-9:10am, pick up 11:50-12:00pm,
 - FRI: Drop off 9:15-9:25, pick up 12:05-12:15
- Uppercase C (MWF): Drop off 1:00-1:10pm, pick up 3:50-4:00pm
- Lowercase A (M/W): Drop off 9:15-9:25am, pick Up 12:05-12:15pm
- Lowercase B (T/TH): Drop off 9:15-9:25am, pick Up 12:05-12:15pm
- Lowercase C (M/W): Drop off 12:45-12:55pm. pick up 3:50-4:00pm

HELP KEEP OUR STUDENTS SAFE AND THE TRAFFIC FLOWING:

- Please attach your car name tag to your passenger side visor with an elastic. We need to see this at drop-off and pick-up!
- Each family received two car tags. Please email us at info@littlelearnersutah.com if you need more than two and we will get those made.
- By having your name tag it ensures safety to our students that we have an approved person picking up your child as well as helps with the flow of traffic in the line.
- Please note: we only unload and loading students through the passenger side. Please make arrangements for seating or have them climb under their sibling seats or enter and exit through the front door. **We will not unload or load on the driver's side for the safety of students as well as our staff.**
- If you can unbuckle before getting to the drop-off point that is super helpful too!
- After loading if your child needs help with buckling please pull ½ way around the circle to buckle up. DO NOT pull into a stall to buckle, this interrupts the flow of traffic.
- Please use caution by looking over your shoulder and using your blinker before pulling out of the line. Please remain patient with the car in front of you by not going around them and progressing forward before they have had a chance to leave the lane.
- Please share our parking lot policies with anyone that will be dropping off or picking up your child.

SEPTEMBER SKILL OF FOCUS

LOWERCASE: In our three-year-old class, the emphasis this month will be placed on Sorting and classifying objects, and recognizing line drawings and objects in pictures. We will be working with math manipulatives and learning the basic shapes, recognizing numbers and recognizing differences. Small motor skill exercises will be used in order to help them with cutting and handwriting. They will begin tracing the letters in their names this month.

UPPERCASE: In our four-year-old class, we will be placing emphasis on sight and sound recognition of the alphabet, as well as handwriting of the letters, A, B, and C with the sight words and, I, see. We will also be working on phonics, blends, digraphs, and math. We will begin our lending library in the third week of school. Your child will be sent home with a reader in a ziplock bag with their name on it. Readers go out on Friday's to be returned the following Friday. If your student knows their letter sounds, let them sound out the words to you.

SEPTEMBER THEME

The theme for this month is the nursery rhymes and circus. We will be learning about circus animals, clowns, circus acts and classic nursery rhymes.

We will be jumping into a welcome to preschool project. Also, we have wear BLUE this month!
